TRANSPORTATION

A. Short Range Transit Plan (SRTP) 2025-2034

Purpose: Ventura County Transportation Commission staff and consultants Fehr and Peers will be presenting the Ventura County Short Range Transit Plan. **(Verbal Presentation, No Staff Report) (Staff: Michelle Woomer)**

JEREMIAH LA ROSE, A CONSULTANT FROM FEHR AND PEERS, PRESENTED THE SHORT RANGE TRANSIT PLAN (SRTP) TO THE COMMITTEE. MAYOR CHRIS ENEGREN COMMENTED THAT THE SRTP'S RECOMMENDATION TO ELIMINATE FIXED ROUTE SERVICE TO THE EASTERN PORTION OF THE CITY MAY CREATE AN ISSUE FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO LIVE IN THAT AREA, DUE TO THE LACK OF FIXED ROUTE SERVICE TO THE HIGH SCHOOL. PUBLIC WORKS STAFF MENTIONED THAT THE PROPOSAL TO ELIMINATE VCTC EAST COUNTY INTERCITY SERVICE FROM THOUSAND OAKS TO MOORPARK WOULD CREATE A TRANSIT SERVICE GAP FOR MOORPARK RESIDENTS WHO NEED TRANSIT SERVICE TO THOUSAND OAKS. CLAIRE GRASTY, TRANSIT DIRECTOR FOR VCTC MENTIONED THAT THEY WILL TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION ALL THE ISSUES RAISED BY THE TPW COMMITTEE IN DRAFTING THE FINAL PLAN. SHE EXPLAINED THAT THE FINAL DRAFT OF THE REPORT WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE VCTC BOARD IN MARCH 2026 FOR APPROVAL.

B. Parking Agreement for the Metrolink Station

Purpose: Discuss Cooperative Agreement between Ventura County Transportation Commission and City of Moorpark for use of Moorpark Metrolink Station North and South Parking lots for public parking. **(Verbal Presentation, No Staff Report) (Staff: Michelle Woomer)**

CLAIRE GRASTY, VCTC TRANSIT DIRECTOR, UPDATED THE COMMITTEE ON THE PUBLIC PARKING AGREEMENT. SHE MENTIONED THAT METROLINK STAFF ARE PLANNING TO VISIT THE MOORPARK METROLINK SITE TO EVALUATE THE REQUEST TO USE THE NORTH AND SOUTH METROLINK PARKING LOTS FOR NON TRANSIT RELATED USE.
