A. Traffic Safety Purpose: To discuss traffic safety at Tierra Rejada Road/Walnut Creek Road. (Verbal Presentation, No Staff Report) (Staff: Daniel Kim)

DANIEL KIM PROVIDED INFORMATION TO THE COMMITTEE REGARDING TRAFFIC SAFETY CONCERNS RECEIVED FROM RESIDENTS FOR THE INTERSECTION OF TIERRA REJADA ROAD AND WALNUT CREEK ROAD. SERGEANT DAVID ANAYA PROVIDED REPORTS ON TRAFFIC COLLISIONS THAT HAVE OCCURRED ON TIERRA REJADA DATING BACK TO 2019. HE GAVE INPUT ON HIS EXPERIENCE PATROLLING THIS AREA OF THE CITY AND CAUSE OF ACCIDENTS THAT HAVE

OCCURRED ON TIERRA REJADA ROAD. DANIEL KIM, SERGEANT DAVID ANAYA AND JEREMY LAURENTOWSKI DISCUSSED VARIOUS WAYS TO SLOW TRAFFIC DOWN AND HELP ALERT DRIVERS OF THE TRAFFIC LIGHT ON TIERRA REJADA ROAD AND WALNUT CREEK ROAD. MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SPOKE REGARDING THEIR CONCERNS AND SUPPORT FOR INSTALLATION OF A FLASHING YELLOW BEACON LIGHT AT AN AREA ON WESTBOUND TIERRA REJADA. COUNCILMEMBERS CASTRO AND ENEGREN ASKED STAFF TO COME BACK TO THE COMMITTEE AND PROVIDE EVIDENCE BASED TRAFFIC MITIGATION MEASURES THAT WILL HELP ADDRESS RESIDENTS CONCERNS.

B. Traffic Signals Purpose: To discuss flashing yellow left-turn arrow for permissive movement. (Verbal Presentation, No Staff Report) (Staff: Daniel Kim)

DANIEL KIM DISCUSSED PROPOSED FLASHING YELLOW LEFT-TURN ARROW TRAFFIC SIGNALS FOR VARIOUS INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY. SERGEANT DAVID ANAYA NOTIFIED THE COMMITTEE THAT MOST MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENTS OCCUR AT LEFT HAND TURNS. COUNCILMEMBERS CASTRO AND ENEGREN HAD CONCERNS REGARDING SAFETY AND COST; AND RECOMMENDED TO HOLD OFF ON THE PROJECT.
