


The Wrath & the Dawn, Renée Ahdieh

Miles Morales: the Ultimate Spider-Man, Brian Michael Bendis




Incendiary, Zoraida Córdova

Superman: Dawnbreaker, Matt de la Peña



Kindred, a graphic novel adaptation, Damian Duffy & Octavia E. Butler




Michael Vey: The Prisoner of Cell 25, Richard Paul Evans

The Gilded Ones, Namina Forna



Caraval, Stephanie Garber




Salt, Maurice Gee

Howl's Moving Castle, Diana Wynn Jones




A Wizard of Earthsea, Ursula K. Le Guin

Legend, Marie Lu



Want, Cindy Pon




Runaways: Find Your Way Home, Rainbow Rowell

Scythe, Neal Shusterman




Nimona, Noelle Stevenson

Rebelwing, Andrea Tang


