Financial Aid Program

This program gives Moorpark residents who may not be able to afford program fees an opportunity to participate in recreational activities in our community. Financial Aid awards can be used to help pay the fees for certain programs that are offered through the City of Moorpark, including Camp Moorpark, Moorpark Little Learners Academy, Youth Basketball Leagues, Recreation Classes, registered events, and fee-based Library and Active Adult Center programs.

Financial Aid is awarded on an annual basis. The Financial Aid year starts on June 1 and goes until May 30. Any scholarship award that is not used by May 30 will be returned to the Financial Aid fund. Residents may apply once each year to participate in the program.

Financial Aid is awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-served basis. Financial Aid may not be available for all qualified applicants.

How Financial Aid Works

Financial Aid awards help pay the fees for certain programs as detailed in this brochure. Financial Aid pays for 50% of program fees, up to the maximum awarded amount. The participant is responsible for paying the other 50% of the fee amount. After the maximum Financial Aid limit has been reached, continued participation requires full fee payment by the participant. Maximum annual Financial Aid awards are as follows:

- **Moorpark Little Learners Academy Preschool:** \$1,500
- **Camp Moorpark:** \$1,000
- **All Other Programs:** \$200

The following rules and restrictions apply to all Financial Aid awards:

- Fees paid by Financial Aid cannot be refunded or transferred.
- Financial Aid awards cannot be redeemed as cash or credit.
- Financial Aid awards cannot be applied to prior registrations or payments.
- Financial Aid awards must be used by the end of the year (May 30, 2026).
- The maximum Financial Aid award per household is \$2,500.
- Recipients who do not use at least 75% of the Financial Aid award will not be eligible to apply for Financial Aid for the following year.
- Current City employees and their family members are not eligible for this program.

Who Can Get Financial Aid?



The Financial Aid program is available to qualifying low income Moorpark residents (for children under 18, both the child and parent/guardian must reside within Moorpark city limits).

Qualification is based on total family gross income. Family income includes all sources of income for the family (defined as all persons living in the home), including wages, public assistance, alimony, child support, etc.

How to Apply

To apply for the Financial Aid program, complete the Financial Aid Application. Submit the completed application, along with all required documents, to:

Applications will be reviewed within 10 business days of receipt. Your application cannot be accepted if any part of the application is not filled out or information is missing, the application is not signed, or any required documents are missing. Please make sure to fill out the application completely, sign it, and turn in all required documents with it.

The Financial Aid program is available to a limited number of qualifying residents. **Applications will be accepted until May 31.** After this date, applications will only be accepted if space is available.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

The following documents are required to verify residency (address within Moorpark city limit):

- ☞ Copy of valid CA driver's license or ID card of the head of household (as named on the application) **and**
- ☞ Current utility bill addressed to the head of household

The following documents are required to verify income:

- ☞ Proof of **current** enrollment in one of the following: CalFresh, WIC, CalWorks, or Medi-cal (*document must have an issue and/or expiration date*)

OR

- ☞ Copy of current Federal tax return **and**
- ☞ Copy of current pay check stub (60 days) **and**
- ☞ Copies of documentation of child support, alimony, public assistance, or other monies or income received.

All documents will be kept confidential and used solely for the purpose of determining eligibility for the Financial Aid program. The City of Moorpark reserves the right to accept or reject any application.
