

## **Area Housing Authority Board of Commissioners**

The Area Housing Authority is an independent, non-profit agency serving the residents of Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks and the unincorporated areas of Ventura County. The Area Housing Authority is governed by a 15-member Board of Commissioners. Each jurisdiction appoints two Commissioners to serve a 4-year term. In addition, one Resident Commissioner is appointed "at-large".

### **Duties:**

The Board of Commissioners is responsible for the Area Housing Authority's policies, finances and operations. The Area Housing Authority's primary mandate is to provide decent and affordable housing accommodations for very low income families, elderly, handicapped and disabled individuals.

The Board meets monthly at 1400 West Hillcrest Drive, Newbury Park, California.

A report shall be required for each scheduled meeting of the agency, authority, district, commission or committee and is due in written form to the City Council five (5) days following the meeting. An e-mail report is acceptable.

In lieu of a written report, an oral report may be presented to the Council under the public comment portion of the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting after the meeting of the agency, authority, district, etc.

### **Term:**

Four-years and until a successor is appointed. The expiration date of all terms shall be August 31.

### **Appointment:**

Two commissioners appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council.

### **Qualifications:**

In order to be considered for City Council appointment the applicant must be a resident of the City of Moorpark and shall also be a registered voter, in the City of Moorpark.

### **Compensation:**

\$50.00 stipend from the Area Housing Authority for each Board meeting attended up to a maximum payment of \$200.00 a month. Commissioners are paid mileage.
