Duties:

The Parks and Recreation Commission meets on the first Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall at 323 Science Drive, to review matters pertaining to the City's parks and public recreation. Other meetings may be required. The Commission also advises the City Council on administration and development of recreation areas, facilities, programs and improved recreation services. When directed by Council, the Commission considers and recommends conceptual design of parks and park facility improvements, including play equipment and other park amenities.

Term:

Two-years with an expiration date of December 31 or until a successor is appointed.

Appointment:

Five commissioners appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be a resident of the City of Moorpark and registered to vote in Moorpark.

All applicants will be required to attend a regular City Council meeting, typically in December,9 to make a brief presentation (not to exceed three minutes) on qualifications and interest in the appointment. Failure to make a presentation shall result in disqualification for appointment. Use of a PowerPoint presentation will be permitted if the City Clerk has been provided with the file no less than 24 hours prior to the meeting.

Compensation:

Members of the Parks and Recreation Commission receive compensation for their attendance at each meeting as approved by resolution of the City Council. Current compensation for Parks and Recreation Commissioners is \$100 per meeting not to exceed 2 meetings per month.
