Duties:

The Planning Commission meets on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Community Center, 799 Moorpark Avenue. Other meetings may be required. The Commission considers such matters as the general plan, specific plans, re-zonings, use permits, and subdivisions. The Planning Commission is the City Council's advisor on land use planning.

Term:

Two-years with an expiration date of December 31 or until a successor is appointed.

Appointment:

Five commissioners appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be a resident of the City of Moorpark, registered to vote in Moorpark; and where possible, should have a special knowledge in the fields of real property, construction, law, zoning, and architecture, or related subjects.

All applicants will be required to attend a regular City Council meeting in February to make a brief presentation (not to exceed three minutes) on qualifications and interest in the appointment. Failure to make a presentation shall result in disqualification for appointment. Use of a PowerPoint presentation will be permitted if the City Clerk has been provided with the file no less than 24 hours prior to the meeting.

Compensation:

Members of the Planning Commission receive compensation for their attendance at each meeting as approved by resolution of the City Council. Current compensation for Planning Commissioners is \$100 per meeting not to exceed 2 meetings per month.

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
