

Walking/Hiking Club Outings

2nd & 4th Wednesdays of every month. Pre-registration not required. Participants should be physically fit and prepared for trails with at least some rocky and/or uneven surfaces. Wear sunscreen, a hat, and sturdy shoes with closed-toe & good tread. Bring plenty of water. No pets. Rain or fire cancels.

Oak Creek Loop to Los Robles/Los Padres Loop Wed, Mar 11, 2026 9-11 a.m.



4 miles with about 500' elevation gain/loss

On the south side of the Conejo Valley, these well-maintained trails traverse oak woodlands, grasslands, sage scrub and chaparral, offering a nice sampling of native plant communities in our local open space.

Meet at Oak Creek Canyon trailhead

From 101 freeway in Thousand Oaks:

Drive south on Moorpark Rd about ½ mile.

Turn right on Greenmeadow and continue driving ½ mile to parking area.

Coyote Hills to Canyon View Trail in Simi Valley Wed, Mar 25, 2026 9-11 a.m.

3.5 mile loop with about 500' elevation gain/loss

Explore local trails near Wood Ranch, Bridle Path & Simi homes. From a neighborhood park, trails rise to a ridge with views across the valley & beyond.

Meet at Coyote Hills Park in Simi Valley 275 Valley Gate Road

From 23 freeway in Moorpark, drive east on Tierra Rejada 3½ miles.

Right on Sinaloa Rd 2 miles. Right on Valley Gate 0.2 miles to park on left.

Lynnmere Trail to Lynn Road in T.O. - Two hike options Wed, April 8, 2026

Option #1 - 9-10:30 a.m. 3 mile out-&-back with about 350' elevation gain/loss.

Option #2 - 9-11:30 a.m. 5 mile loop with about 700' elevation gain/loss.

Both options are on trails through chaparral and sage scrub on the south side of Wildwood Park. The longer option includes descending into Wildwood Canyon.

Meet at neighborhood trail-access point. From Lynn Road near Los Robles Hospital: Drive west on Janss Road 0.7 miles. Right on Lynnmere Dr and park on right side of street across from homes. Trail-access point is just before the security gate.

Newbury Park - Dos Vientos to Vista Del Mar Wed, Apr 22, 2026 9-11 a.m.

4 mile round trip with about 400' elevation gain/loss (or choose optional 5 mile 600') Trails with neighborhood access wind through native habitat. Nearby views are of the Dos Vientos residential area. Distant views include Mugu State Park, Santa Monica Mountains, Ocean, Islands, Camarillo and Thousand Oaks.

Reverse direction at scenic overlook (or at 'the ponds') to return mostly on same trails.

Meet at trail-access point on Via Del Rancho in Dos Vientos residential area

From 101 freeway in Thousand Oaks:

Drive southwest on Lynn Road 5.25 miles. Right on Via Las Brisas 0.6 mile.

U-turn at Via Grande, then right onto Via Del Rancho ½ mile to end.

Use street parking beyond homes. Please avoid parking in front of homes.
