The Fine Print (Registration Policies):

All participants (parents/guardians for minors) must sign a hold harmless agreement prior to participation.

Registrations are taken on a first come/first served basis, unless otherwise noted. Programs may be combined or canceled as necessary if the minimum enrollment is not met. Program information is subject to change.

Payment: Payment is due at the time of registration. We accept cash, check, and credit card. *Phone registrations must be paid by credit card.* There is a \$35 fee for returned checks.

Withdrawals: Requests for withdrawals must be received as follows: 1) 1-session/single date programs: at least 1 business day prior to program date, 2) 2+ session programs: prior to the 2nd meeting date, 3) Adult sports leagues: prior to the posting of the game schedule. Please note: Special withdrawal policies apply to certain programs including Camp Moorpark and Moorpark Little Learners Academy.

Refunds/credits are pro-rated, and costs incurred by the City or instructor are deducted from refunds/credits. Refunds also incur a refund processing fee. **For details on these policies, please visit Moorparkca.gov/Cancel.**

Cancellations by City: Refunds or credits will be issued for programs cancelled by the City.

Make-Up Dates: In the event of rain-outs (outdoor classes only) or instructor absence, a make-up date will be scheduled for missed classes. Refunds/credits are not available if a participant cannot attend the make-up date. Notifications for rain-outs will be sent via email.

Accommodations: Reasonable accommodations will be provided to participants on a case-by-case basis. If you need a special accommodation, please notify Recreation Division staff at least two weeks prior to your program start date.





- Amplified sound and live music
- Commercial filming or photography
- Exclusive use of a park amenity


