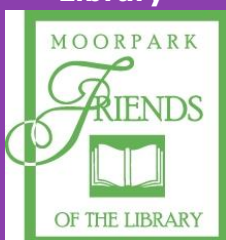

Preschool Learning Time

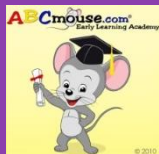
Wednesday, January 30 from 10:30 – 11:15 a.m.
