All supplies provided for making colorful slime!

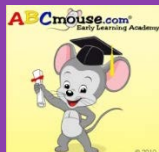
Preschool Learning Time

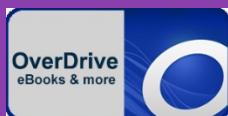
Free professional online tutoring daily from 1 – 10pm in all subjects and grade levels. Access Brainfuse at home or in the library from our website.
