


How to Vote By Mail

This is a Vote By Mail (VBM) election! Your ballot will be mailed to you automatically. You do NOT need to request a VBM ballot.


Official VBM ballots will be mailed out beginning October 2, 2020.

Vote By Mail Materials:


Outgoing Shipping Envelope



Official Ballot




Postage-Paid Return Envelope



Follow These Easy Steps:




Automatically receive your Official VBM Ballot.




Fill in the oval to the right of your choices. Use BLUE or BLACK ink only.

Optional Write-in: To vote for a qualified write-in candidate, write the person's name in the blank space and fill in the oval.

Place marked ballot card(s) into the return envelope.



Seal and **sign the back** of the return envelope. Only ballots with signatures matching the voter's record are counted.



Return your ballot via mail – no postage needed! – or return to any Drop Box or In-Person Voting Location (see pages 5 and 6 for locations).
