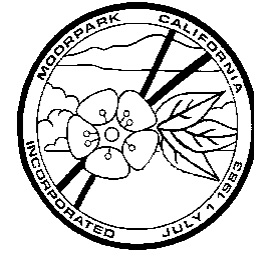

Animal License Notice

Dear Pet Owner: Our records indicate that your pet(s) need a license. All dogs and cats in Moorpark are required by law to have a license. (See the ordinance below for details.)

DOG AND CAT LICENSE REQUIRED: City of Moorpark Ordinance 6.16.010 A. "Every person who owns, harbors, or keeps any dog or cat over the age of four (4) months within the city for thirty (30) days or longer must maintain a current license and license tag issued as required by this title for each dog or cat."

Avoid a late fee penalty by renewing your current license within 30 days of the due date. Late penalties are 100 % (double) the above listed rate. For example, the late fee on a twelve month license for an altered dog or cat is \$30 plus the license fee, for a total of \$60. **Online licensing is now available at www.vcas.us.**

RABIES VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

All dogs over the age of four months must be vaccinated against rabies. A dog license is valid only when the required rabies vaccination certificate, issued by a licensed veterinarian, is provided to the Department, and only as long as the rabies vaccination is effective (sec. 53.51)

Owner must provide a copy of:

- a.) **RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE AND**
- b.) **SURGICAL STERILIZATION CERTIFICATE (If applicable).**
